The local team were able to provide food and share the word of God, which we know that it would bring peace, love and joy to the communities in this tough season.

Situation Update

The security situation in Myanmar continues to deteriorate, with armed clashes taking place in many parts of the country. In the first quarter of 2024, fighting has intensified particularly in Rakhine, Kachin, Sagaing and the Southeast. Conflict, involving the deployment of heavy weapon, aerial bombardment and shooting, has driven a surge in displacement, civilian casualties, protection risks, and humanitarian needs. More than 2.8 million men, women and children are internally displaced, with the vast majority- more than 2.5 million-forced from their homes by conflict and insecurity since the 2021 military takeover.

From the recent update by our local team, the areas that we have served and distributed food has continually been involved in persistent conflict. Each time, there is aerial bombardment and artillery shelling, the villagers have to flee from their home and hide in the jungle. With the ongoing conflicts and increasing fear of forced recruitment and conscription that was announced in early February, people from other villages have come to seek refuge.
