Situation Update

Three years after the military takeover in February 2021, the people of Myanmar continue to face the impacts of a conflict that spans numerous states and regions. According to most recent reports, more than 2.7 million people are now displaced nationwide, with the vast majority (2.4 million) fleeing their homes due to conflict and insecurity after the military takeover. Intensified armed conflict, administrative restrictions (including refusal of travel authorizations), and violence against aid workers all remain key barriers that are limiting humanitarian organizations' capacity to access affected communities and deliver lifesaving assistance. In this past month, our local partners have reported that their food distribution schedules had to be postponed due to daily airstrikes in the area we serve. All civilians in the village were forced to evacuate their homes and hide in the jungle for several days. In addition, due to recruitment shortfalls and battlefield losses the military regime revived the Military Service Law on February 10, requiring men ages 18 to 35 and women ages 18 to 27 to serve a minimum of two years in the military. Following this announcement, many families in Myanmar sought refuge in areas predominantly occupied by armed groups to avoid military service. Some have come to the area where our local partners serve, and our partners have been using this opportunity to share the good news of Jesus and minister to them. Hallelujah!

Also, one church leader in that area also offered these families a job working in cassava fields so they can have some income.
